ORDER

This order shall dispose off the appeal filed by Shri Praveen Gandotra, Appellant in respect of his application dated 12.05.16 vide ID No.270 dated 11.04.2016 U/s 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005. Shri Praveen Gandotra appellant was present for hearing on 26.05.16.

The appellant in his appeal has prayed that the ARCS (Policy) in para 3 of his reply dated 11.04.16 has stated "High Court vide its order has directed to provide the copy of deficiencies to petitioners counsel and not for Court Commissioner or High Court. In fact as per the legal procedure copies of pleadings/averments made by the parties are filed in the court supported with an affidavit and copies thereof are to be supplied to the parties in the suit. Even though the Hon'ble Court has directed the RCS to furnish copies of deficiencies, if any, to the Counsel of the petitioner, it cannot be implied or construed that the copies of Deficiencies supported with requisite Affidavit should neither filed in the Court nor supplied to the Ld. Court Commissioner against whom allegations were labeled by the RCS. This was done with mollified intentions by the concerned officer to keep the Hon'ble Court (Successor Court) in dark and to delay justice to the Petitioners." Concerned officer be directed that copies of lists of deficiencies supported with an affidavit be filed in the Court by the Respondent (RCS).

On perusal of the case it is noticed that the PIO (Policy) has already furnished the requisite information on RTI application of appellant on 11.04.16. The directions of Hon'ble High Court have already been complied with by the Department. The case is still subjudice before Hon'ble High Court and the directions of the Hon'ble High Court, if any will be complied with by the Department in future.

The appeal is disposed off accordingly.

As per Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005, the appellant may file an appeal, if any, within 90 days of the issue of this order before Second Appellate Authority i.e. Central Information Commission, August Kranti Bhawan, Bhikaji Kama Place, New Delhi.
